A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing October 30, 2013, as "Daughters of the Nile Day" in
- 2 Pennsylvania in honor of the 100th anniversary of the
- 3 Daughters of the Nile.
- 4 WHEREAS, Daughters of the Nile is an international fraternal
- 5 organization for women 18 years of age or older, who are related
- 6 by birth or marriage to a Shriner, Master Mason or Daughter of
- 7 the Nile or are majority members in good standing of a Masonic-
- 8 related organization for girls; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Founded in 1913 in Seattle, Washington, Daughters of
- 10 the Nile members now total over 26,000 in 139 cities throughout
- 11 the United States and Canada; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Daughters of the Nile maintains active temples in
- 13 Altoona, Erie, Harrisburg, Philadelphia and Pittsburgh; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The members of Daughters of the Nile are proud of
- 15 their long association with Shriners International and their

- 1 continuing support of Shriners Hospitals for Children, a network
- 2 of 22 hospitals throughout the United States, Canada and Mexico
- 3 that provide pediatric care for specialty areas of orthopedics,
- 4 burns, spinal cord injuries and cleft lip and palate, regardless
- 5 of the patients' ability to pay; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Through the Daughters of the Nile Foundation and
- 7 Canadian Trust, Daughters of the Nile contributes over \$1.7
- 8 million each year to Shriners Hospitals for Children to be used
- 9 for the medical care and rehabilitation of children; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Since 1924, Daughters of the Nile has contributed
- 11 more than \$50 million to this cause; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In recognition of monetary contributions by
- 13 Daughters of the Nile, Shriners Hospitals for Children have
- 14 placed gold plaques, each representing \$1 million, on the
- 15 philanthropic walls of all 22 hospitals; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Twelve hospitals have two gold plagues and three
- 17 hospitals have three gold plaques; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Each year, the members of Daughters of the Nile give
- 19 generously of their time and talents by providing more than
- 20 150,000 volunteer hours at the Shriners Hospitals for Children;
- 21 and
- 22 WHEREAS, In addition, they sew clothing and quilts and
- 23 provide toys, books, games and other educational and
- 24 recreational items, with an annual value well over \$900,000;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize October
- 27 30, 2013, as "Daughters of the Nile Day" in Pennsylvania in
- 28 honor of the 100th anniversary of Daughters of the Nile and
- 29 recognize Daughters of the Nile's support of Shriners Hospitals
- 30 for Children.
