A RESOLUTION

- l Urging the Congress of the United States to include a
- 2 representation of Sojourner Truth in the Portrait Monument
- 3 honoring the women's suffrage movement in the Rotunda of the
- 4 United States Capitol.
- 5 WHEREAS, Sojourner Truth was a leader of women's rights in
- 6 the 19th century and stands as a symbol of the women's
- 7 suffragist movement in the United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Portrait Monument honoring the women's suffrage
- 9 movement in the Rotunda of the United States Capitol consists of
- 10 representations of Susan B. Anthony, Elizabeth Cady Stanton and
- 11 Lucretia Mott sculpted in marble; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Portrait Monument, created to honor pioneers and
- 13 leaders of women's suffrage in the United States, is incomplete
- 14 without a representation of Sojourner Truth; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 16 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress to include a
- 17 representation of Sojourner Truth in the Portrait Monument
- 18 honoring the women's suffrage movement in the Rotunda of the

- 1 United States Capitol; AND BE IT FURTHER
- RESOLVED, THAT COPIES OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO 2
