## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled 1 2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating 3 thereto, " further providing for contracts. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. The introductory paragraph and clause (2) of 8 subsection (d) of section 1802 of the act of June 24, 1931 9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code, reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and 10 11 amended July 10, 1990 (P.L.389, No.92), are amended to read: 12 Section 1802. General Regulations Concerning Contracts. -- \* \* 13 14 The contracts or purchases made by the commissioners 15 [involving an expenditure of over ten thousand dollars,] which 16 shall not require advertising [or], bidding or price quotations, as hereinbefore provided, are as follows: 17

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
