A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating the Philadelphia Eagles on their Super Bowl LII 2 win on February 4, 2018, against the New England Patriots.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Eagles finished the 2017-2018
- 4 regular season as the NFC East Division Champions with a record
- 5 of 13 wins and 3 losses, clinching the home field advantage by
- 6 being the number one seed in the NFC; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Philadelphia Eagles beat the Minnesota Vikings
- 8 38-7 in the NFC Championship game on January 21, 2018, to earn
- 9 their spot in Super Bowl LII; and
- 10 WHEREAS, On February 4, 2018, the Philadelphia Eagles won
- 11 Super Bowl LII in Minneapolis, Minnesota, under the guidance of
- 12 their second-year Head Coach, Doug Pederson, against the AFC

- 1 number one seeded New England Patriots, with their five-time
- 2 Super Bowl winning quarterback Tom Brady; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Eagles were considered underdogs for much of the
- 4 postseason due to a season-ending injury to their starting
- 5 quarterback, Carson Wentz, late in the regular season, as well
- 6 as multiple other injuries to starting players; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Backup quarterback Nick Foles stepped in to finish
- 8 the season, started in Super Bowl LII and threw for 373 yards
- 9 and three touchdowns; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Nick Foles was named Super Bowl LII MVP and became
- 11 the first player to ever throw for and catch a touchdown pass in
- 12 a Super Bowl; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Multiple players contributed to the win with a total
- 14 of five touchdowns in Super Bowl LII, including Nick Foles, Trey
- 15 Burton, LeGarrette Blount, Corey Clement, Alshon Jeffery and
- 16 Zach Ertz, who caught the game-winning touchdown pass; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Rookie Kicker Jake Elliott made three out of three
- 18 field goals, with his longest kick being 46 yards, which
- 19 extended the lead late in the fourth quarter; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Eagles accumulated 538 total yards of offense,
- 21 which contributed to a Super Bowl record of 1,151 total combined
- 22 yards by two teams; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The Eagles clinched the Super Bowl victory over the
- 24 New England Patriots with a score of 41-33, bringing the most
- 25 passionate fan base in the NFL a thrilling victory; and
- 26 WHEREAS, The Eagles have previously played in the Super Bowl
- 27 three times but this is their first Super Bowl victory and
- 28 parade down Broad Street in Philadelphia; and
- 29 WHEREAS, The Eagles have proven their ability to overcome
- 30 adversity and to continually succeed as a team; therefore be it
