## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of October 19 through 25, 2014, as "National Chemistry Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, National Chemistry Week is an annual event designed
- 4 to raise awareness of the importance of chemistry in everyday
- 5 life, and 2014 marks the 27th anniversary of National Chemistry
- 6 Week; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Chemical Society created National
- 8 Chemistry Week to be a community-based initiative that unites
- 9 local sections of the society with schools, businesses and
- 10 individuals; and
- 11 WHEREAS, More than 96% of all manufactured goods involve some
- 12 form of chemistry, making chemistry an essential part of every
- 13 facet of this nation's economy; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The business of chemistry is a significant

- 1 contributor to the economy of this Commonwealth, employing
- 2 nearly 47,000 people; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Chemistry is intimately involved in the processing
- 4 and preparation of food, and this year's theme, "The Sweet Side
- 5 of Chemistry Candy," celebrates that involvement by showcasing
- 6 the chemistry involved in making candy and confections; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The evolving science of chemistry is essential to
- 8 this Commonwealth's industry and the well-being of all
- 9 Pennsylvanians; therefore be it
