AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class 3 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and 4 changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for 5 tax levies.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known
- 9 as the Second Class County Code, is amended by adding a section
- 10 to read:
- 11 Section 1970.4. Tax Levy for Police Services. -- Every county
- 12 of the second class may levy an annual tax not exceeding three
- 13 mills to support a police department which serves the county
- 14 solely, to support the county's participation in a regional
- 15 police department or to pay for the purchase of police services
- 16 for the county. If an annual tax for the purposes specified in
- 17 this section is proposed to be set at a level higher than three
- 18 mills, the question shall be submitted to the voters of the

- 1 county and the county board of elections shall frame the
- 2 <u>question in accordance with the election laws of this</u>
- 3 <u>Commonwealth for submission to the voters of the county.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
