AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), entitled "An act creating the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources consisting of certain functions of the Department 3 of Environmental Resources and the Department of Community Affairs; renaming the Department of Environmental Resources as the Department of Environmental Protection; defining the role of the Environmental Quality Board in the Department of 7 Environmental Protection; making changes to responsibilities 8 of the State Conservation Commission and the Department of 9 Agriculture; transferring certain powers and duties to the 10 Department of Health; and repealing inconsistent acts," in 11 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, further 12 providing for community recreation and heritage conservation. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Section 306 of the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, 17 No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources Act, is 18 amended by adding a subsection to read: 19 Section 306. Community recreation and heritage conservation.

- 2 PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND ASSOCIATED RECREATION AREAS, the
- 3 department shall give priority to projects that correct
- 4 <u>accessibility deficiencies for individuals with a disability</u>,
- 5 <u>including accessible playground equipment, such as ramped,</u>
- 6 ground-level play features, accessible swings, wheelchair
- 7 <u>accessible tables</u>, <u>adjustable equipment</u>, <u>universally accessible</u>
- 8 swings, transfer platforms, sensory play equipment, and
- 9 <u>adaptations for blind and visually impaired individuals. The</u>
- 10 department shall prioritize projects that create a recreation
- 11 area universally designed to meet the needs of all individuals
- 12 and where all equipment, and the recreation area itself, is
- 13 accessible for individuals with a disability over projects that
- 14 would create a recreation area where only some equipment, or
- 15 only the recreation area itself, is accessible for individuals
- 16 with a disability.

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
