7	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 3718. Use of windshield wipers and lights.
10	(a) General ruleIt is unlawful for the driver of a motor
11	vehicle to fail to turn on the motor vehicle's lights any time
12	the vehicle's windshield wiper system is in operation.
13	(b) PenaltyA person who violates this section commits a
14	summary offense.
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
