AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the first, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, 3 revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by counties, 5 including authorizing imposition of an excise tax on the 6 rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and 7 providing for regional renaissance initiatives," further providing for applicability and for the abolishment of the 9 office of jury commissioner. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 102(a) of the act of August 9, 1955 14 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended December 15 15, 2011 (P.L.442, No.108), amendment declared unconstitutional, 16 Pennsylvania State Association of Jury Commissioners v. 17 Commonwealth No.66 MAP 2012 (Pa. 2013), is amended to read: 18 Section 102. - 14 office of jury commissioner. Upon approval of the resolution,
