HOUSE BILL No. 1274 Session of 1991

INTRODUCED BY EVANS, APRIL 23, 1991

AS AMENDED ON THIRD CONSIDERATION, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, MAY 7, 1991

AN ACT

Amending the act of July 1, 1990 (P.L. , No.7A), entitled "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for 4 5 the fiscal year July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1991, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 6 7 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990; to provide appropriations from the State Lottery Fund, the Pennsylvania 8 9 Economic Revitalization Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, The State Stores Fund and the Emergency 10 Medical Services Operating Fund to the Executive Department; 11 to provide appropriations from the Judicial Computer System 12 13 Augmentation Account to the Judicial Department; to provide 14 appropriations from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1991, for the proper operation 15 of the several departments of the Commonwealth and the 16 17 Pennsylvania State Police authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys; and to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments of the 18 19 20 Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipts 21 accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1991, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at 22 23 the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990," 24 increasing and decreasing certain appropriations to the Executive Department; and making appropriations from the 25 26 Hazardous Material Response Fund.
