## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in judicial boards and
- 3 commissions, providing for structured fines.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2154.8. Structured fines.
- 9 (a) Adoption. -- The commission shall adopt quidelines for the
- 10 use of structured fines, in consultation with the planning
- 11 committee established under subsection (b), using guidelines
- 12 <u>found in Monograph NCJ 156242, regarding the use of structured</u>
- 13 <u>fines as an intermediate sanction</u>, of the United States
- 14 Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of
- 15 <u>Justice Assistance</u>.
- 16 (b) Planning committee. -- To aid in the creation of
- 17 <u>structured fine quidelines, the commission shall establish a</u>
- 18 planning committee, which shall be comprised of at least the

- 1 following individuals:
- 2 (1) A chief or presiding judge of a court of common
- 3 pleas.
- 4 <u>(2) A prosecutor.</u>
- 5 <u>(3) A public defender.</u>
- 6 (4) A representative of the private defense bar.
- 7 <u>(5) A court administrator.</u>
- 8 (6) An agency director for pretrial services.
- 9 (7) A chief probation officer or director of a community
- 10 <u>corrections agency within this Commonwealth.</u>
- 11 <u>(8) A sheriff or jail administrator.</u>
- 12 (9) At least three individuals who are active members of
- 13 <u>a criminal justice advocacy group within this Commonwealth.</u>
- 14 (10) Any other individual that the commission finds
- 15 <u>necessary for creating the guidelines.</u>
- 16 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 18 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19 "Structured fine." A monetary sanction adjusted according to
- 20 the seriousness of the offense and the financial status of the
- 21 offender. The term is also referred to as a day fine.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
