21	reckless driving. This section does not relieve the driver of
22	any vehicle in a funeral procession from the duty to drive with
23	due regard for the safety of all persons.
24	(d) Regulations. The department may promulgate any
25	regulation authorized by this section.

27	(a) General rule. Notwithstanding the fact that the
28	operator of a vehicle may be otherwise entitled to the right of
29	<u>way, by virtue of a traffic signal or otherwise, it shall be</u>
30	unlawful for any operator, other than emergency vehicles on

8 (C) CARAVANS AND MOTORCADES.--UPON ANY ROADWAY OUTSIDE OF AN 9 URBAN DISTRICT, MOTOR VEHICLES BEING DRIVEN IN A CARAVAN OR 10 MOTORCADE, WHETHER OR NOT TOWING OTHER VEHICLES, SHALL BE SO 11 OPERATED AS TO ALLOW SUFFICIENT SPACE BETWEEN EACH VEHICLE OR 12 COMBINATION OF VEHICLES SO AS TO ENABLE ANY OTHER VEHICLE TO 13 ENTER AND OCCUPY SPACE WITHOUT DANGER. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT 14 APPLY TO FUNERAL PROCESSIONS, WHICH SHALL NOT BE INTERRUPTED BY 15 ANY VEHICLE OTHER THAN AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE.

16 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
