## AN ACT

Directing the Health Care Cost Containment Council to conduct a 1 study relating to the feasibility of requiring all health 2 insurance plans offered to employees of the Commonwealth 3 STATE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES to be part of a single trust fund 4 for the provision of health insurance plans to the employees 5 and for the council to report the study to the General 6 7 Assembly and to the Governor. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. State health insurance plan study. 11 (A) DUTY TO CONDUCT .-- The Health Care Cost Containment -12 Council shall conduct a study relating to the feasibility of 13 requiring all health insurance plans offered to employees of the 14 Commonwealth STATE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES to be part of a single ← 15 trust fund for the provision of health insurance plans to the 16 employees. The study shall include the cost savings to be 17 realized by the migration of multiple health insurance plans to 18 a single trust fund. 19 (B) DEFINITION.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "STATE GOVERNMENT

EMPLOYEES" OR "EMPLOYEES" MEANS PERSONS WHO ARE EMPLOYED BY ONE
OF THE THREE BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH
AND ARE NOT COVERED UNDER A HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRACT PLAN
NEGOTIATED THROUGH COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

5 Section 2. Report.

6 The Health Care Cost Containment Council shall prepare and 7 transmit a report that includes the findings of the study 8 required under section 1 to the chairman of the Finance 9 Committee of the Senate and to the chairman of the Finance 10 Committee of the House of Representatives within 6 months of the 11 effective date of this section. 12 Section 3. Effective date.
