- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known 8
- as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to

- 11 Section 443.12. Provider Payment Rates for Individuals with
- an Intellectual Disability or Autism. -- The following shall apply 12
- to home-based and community-based services provided to 13
- 14 individuals with an intellectual disability or autism:
- 15 (1) The department shall maintain and publish in the
- 16 Pennsylvania Bulletin on or before December 31 of each fiscal
- 17 year a detailed description of the calculation of providers'
- payment rates for home-based and community-based services, 18

- 1 including the data, inputs, assumptions, variables, calculations
- 2 and precise methodologies relied on and the source of all data,
- 3 variables and assumptions utilized in establishing the payment
- 4 rates notwithstanding whether the payment rates are developed by
- 5 the department or a third party. The information shall be made
- 6 available by the department to each provider, family and
- 7 consumer for inspection, examination and copying.
- 8 (2) A provider shall submit cost reports to the department,
- 9 or the department's designee, on or before September 30 of each
- 10 fiscal year that identify the costs incurred to render home-
- 11 <u>based and community-based services during the prior fiscal year.</u>
- 12 This paragraph shall expire October 1, 2020.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
