AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for limitations on district justices.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3302 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 3302. Additional restrictions.
9	Judges shall not engage in any activity prohibited by this
10	subchapter or any other provision of law and shall not violate
11	any canon of ethics prescribed by general rule. A district
12	justice shall devote [the] <u>full</u> time [necessary for the prompt
13	and proper disposition of] to the business of his office[, which
14	shall be given priority over any other occupation, business,
15	profession, pursuit or activity. He shall not use or permit the
16	use of the premises established for the disposition of his
17	magisterial business for any other occupation, business,
18	profession or gainful pursuit]. A district justice shall not

[hold any other elected or appointed public office in this] 1 2 <u>engage in the practice of law; hold office in a political party</u> 3 or political organization; or hold an office or position of profit in the government of the United States, the Commonwealth 4 5 or a municipal corporation or political subdivision of the Commonwealth, except in the armed service of the United States 6 or the Commonwealth. District justices and appointive judicial 7 8 officers shall be governed by rules or canons prescribed by 9 general rule.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in one year.
