## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 4, 1978 (P.L.883, No.170), entitled 2 "An act relating to conflicts of interest involving certain 3 public officials serving in State or State agencies and local political subdivision positions and prohibiting certain 5 public employees from engaging in certain conflict of interest activities requiring certain disclosures and 7 providing penalties, "further providing for contracting with governmental bodies by public officials and on the public 8 disclosure thereof, for the practice before certain State 9 agencies by former State employees, and for statements of 10 financial interests. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Subsections (c) and (e) of section 3, and Section 1. 15 paragraph (4) of subsection (b) of section 5, act of October 4, 1978 (P.L.883, No.170), referred to as the Public Official and 16 Employee Ethics Law, are amended to read: 17 Restricted activities. 18 Section 3. 19 20 (1) No public official or public employee or a 21 member of his immediate family or any business in which the 22 person or a member of the person's immediate family is a 23 director, officer, owner or holder of stock exceeding 5% of

- 1 the equity at fair market value of the business shall enter
- 2 into any contract [valued at \$500 or more] with [a] the
- 3 governmental body [unless the contract has been awarded
- 4 through an open and public process, including prior public
- 5 notice and subsequent public disclosure of all proposals
- 6 considered and contracts awarded] of which he is an official
- 7 <u>or employee</u>.
- 8 (2) A public official or public employee or a member of
- 9 <u>his immediate family or any business in which the person or a</u>
- member of the person's immediate family is a director,
- officer, owner or holder of stock exceeding 5% of the equity
- 12 <u>at fair market value of the business may enter into any</u>
- contract with any other governmental body provided that there
- is public disclosure within five days of the making of the
- 15 <u>contract.</u> Any contract made in violation of this subsection
- shall be voidable by a court of competent jurisdiction if the
- suit is commenced within 90 days of making of the contract,
- 18 provided that the disclosure requirement has been met. If
- 19 this requirement has not been met, such suit may be commenced
- 20 at any time.

- 22 [(e) No former official or public employee shall represent a
- 23 person, with or without compensation, on any matter before the
- 24 governmental body with which he has been associated for one year
- 25 after he leaves that body.]
- 26 (e) No official or public employee who is involved in
- 27 contracts, purchasing or rate-making shall for one year
- 28 subsequent to public employment, be employed by any person, firm
- 29 <u>or corporation which contracts with supplies goods or services</u>
- 30 to, or is under the jurisdiction of, the governmental body or

- 1 rate-making agency which employed the public official or
- 2 <u>employee</u>.

- 4 Section 5. Statement of financial interests.

- 6 (b) The statement shall include the following information
- 7 for the prior calendar year with regard to the person required
- 8 to file the statement and the members of his immediate family:

- 10 (4) The name and address of each creditor <u>including</u>
- 11 <u>mortgagees</u> to whom is owed in excess of \$5,000 and the
- interest rate thereon where the interest rate, at the time of
- the making of the loan or mortgage is lower than 2% below the
- 14 <u>prime interest rate existing on that date.</u> However, loans or
- 15 credit extended between members of the immediate family [and
- 16 mortgages securing real property which is the principal
- 17 residence of the person filing or of his spouse] shall not be
- included.

- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
