## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other required equipment, further providing for windshield obstructions and wipers; and abrogating
- 4 regulations.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 4524(b) and (e)(1) of Title 75 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 4524. Windshield obstructions and wipers.

- 11 (b) Obstruction on side and rear windows. -- No person shall
- 12 drive a motor vehicle with any sign, poster or other
- 13 nontransparent material, including ice or snow, [upon] on the
- 14 side wings or side or rear windows of the vehicle which
- 15 materially obstructs, obscures or impairs the driver's clear
- 16 view of the highway or any intersecting highway. The placement
- 17 of a registration permit [upon], window tint, sun screening
- 18 <u>devices or other materials as determined by the department that</u>
- 19 reduce the amount of light transmittance levels into the vehicle

- 1 on the side or rear window of a vehicle shall not be considered
- 2 a material obstruction.

- 4 (e) Sun screening and other materials prohibited. --
- 5 (1) [No] <u>Except as provided in subsection (b), no</u> person
- 6 shall drive any motor vehicle with any sun screening device
- 7 or other material which does not permit a person to see or
- 8 view the inside of the vehicle through the windshield, side
- 9 wing or side window of the vehicle.

- 11 Section 2. All regulations and parts of regulations are
- 12 abrogated insofar as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
