Amending Title 20 (Decedents, Estates and Fiduciaries) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in intestate succession, 2 3 further providing for forfeiture. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 2106 of Title 20 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 2106. Forfeiture. 8 9 10 (b.1) Exceptions to parent's share forfeiture. -- Subsection 11 (b) (1) shall not apply to: 12 (1) a parent of a minor or dependent child who resumed care and maintenance of the minor or dependent child at least 13 14 one year prior to the death of the minor or dependent child 15 and continued the same until the death; or 16 (2) a parent of a minor or dependent child who was 17 deprived of custody of the minor or dependent child under an order of a court of competent jurisdiction and the parent 18

- jurisdiction requiring contribution to the support of the
- 3 minor or dependent child at least one year prior to the death
- 4 of the minor or dependent child and continued the same until

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
