- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2713(a) and (b)(2) and (4) of Title 18 of
- 7 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 2713. Neglect of care-dependent person.
- 9 (a) Offense defined.--A caretaker is guilty of neglect of a
- 10 care-dependent person if he:
- 11 (1) Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes bodily
- injury [or] serious bodily injury or death by failing to
- provide treatment, care, goods or services necessary to
- 14 preserve the health, safety or welfare of a care-dependent
- person for whom he is responsible to provide care.
- 16 (2) Intentionally or knowingly uses a physical restraint
- or chemical restraint or medication on a care-dependent
- person, or isolates a care-dependent person contrary to law

- or regulation, such that bodily injury [or] serious bodily
- 2 injury or death results.

- 5 (2) A violation of subsection (a) (1) constitutes a
- 6 felony of the first degree if the victim suffers serious
- 7 bodily injury or death.

- 9 (4) A violation of subsection (a) (2) constitutes a
- 10 felony of the first degree if the victim suffers serious
- 11 bodily injury or death.
