- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further defining
- 3 "personal staff," insofar as it relates to the Philadelphia
- 4 Traffic Court.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The definition of "personal staff" in section 102
- 8 of Title 42, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known
- 9 as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:
- 10 § 102. Definitions.
- 11 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 12 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 13 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 14 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 15 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:
- 16 * * *
- 17 "Personal staff." Private secretaries, law clerks and such
- 18 other personnel as an individual may be authorized by law to

- select and remove subject to standards and classifications 1
- 2 established by the governing authority. <u>In the case of the</u>
- 3 Philadelphia Traffic Court, each judge thereof shall be
- 4 <u>authorized to select and remove a secretary, administrative</u>
- 5 <u>assistant and clerk</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6
