Amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed)) 1 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and 2 duties, further providing for civil penalties. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3108(b) of Title 63 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 3108. Civil penalties. 8 * * * 9 10 (b) Additional powers. -- In addition to the disciplinary powers and duties of the licensing boards and licensing 11 12 commissions within the bureau under their respective practice 13 acts, licensing boards and licensing commissions shall have the 14 power, respectively: 15 * * * 16 (9) To rescind a license, registration, certification or 17 permit issued by the professional or occupational licensing

board or licensing commission where there is probable cause

- 1 that the license, registration, certification or permit was
- 2 <u>issued based on documentation provided by or on behalf of the</u>
- 3 applicant that was found to be false or fraudulent. The
- 4 <u>licensing board or licensing commission shall provide at</u>
- 5 <u>least 10 BUSINESS days' notice of the rescission of the</u> <--
- 6 license, registration, certification or permit and shall
- 7 offer the applicant the opportunity to demonstrate that the
- 8 license, registration, certification or permit was not issued
- 9 based on false or fraudulent documentation at a post-
- 10 rescission hearing before the appropriate licensing board or
- 11 licensing commission, WHICH SHALL OCCUR WITHIN 20 DAYS OF THE <--
- 12 <u>RESCISSION. IF THE APPLICANT DEMONSTRATES THAT THE LICENSE</u>, <--
- 13 REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATION OR PERMIT WAS NOT ISSUED BASED ON
- 14 FALSE OR FRAUDULENT DOCUMENTATION AT A POST-RESCISSION
- 15 HEARING, THE LICENSING BOARD OR LICENSING COMMISSION MAY NOT,
- ABSENT NEW EVIDENCE OF FALSE OR FRAUDULENT DOCUMENTATION,
- 17 RESCIND THE LICENSE, REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATION OR PERMIT OF
- 18 THE APPLICANT.

- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
