## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for telephone
- 3 solicitation for public utility services.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1512. Telephone solicitation for public utility service.
- 9 (a) Telephone solicitation prohibited.--A public utility or
- 10 an affiliate of a public utility or an entity in the business of
- 11 providing a public utility service shall not initiate a
- 12 <u>telephone call to any residential telephone line in this</u>
- 13 Commonwealth by using voice or artificial or prerecorded voice
- 14 or by any other means for the purpose of soliciting the purchase
- 15 of any public utility service unless the called party
- 16 specifically gave prior written consent authorizing the
- 17 <u>telephone solicitation</u>.
- 18 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following

- 1 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 2 subsection:
- 3 "Entity in the business of providing a public utility
- 4 <u>service." Any marketer, broker, aggregator, reseller, electric</u>
- 5 generator, gas producer, gas transmission company or affiliate
- 6 thereof. The term shall not include any entity which is
- 7 <u>initiating telephone calls to its own members for the purpose of</u>
- 8 soliciting the purchase of any public utility service,
- 9 <u>including</u>, but not limited to, a political subdivision, a group
- 10 or association representing political subdivisions, a Statewide
- 11 <u>farm organization</u>, a chamber of commerce, a labor organization
- 12 or a nonprofit corporation subject to Title 15 (relating to
- 13 <u>corporations and unincorporated associations).</u>
- 14 "Public utility service." Any telephone, electric or gas
- 15 service for which the consumer is permitted to choose the
- 16 provider of that service from a public utility, affiliate of a
- 17 public utility or entity in the business of providing a public
- 18 utility service.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
