AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An
2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying
3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing
4 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment,
5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing
6 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and
7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain
8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations
9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and
10 penalties," further providing for deposit of proceeds.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 602.3 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,
14 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, amended August 4,
15 1991 (P.L.97, No.22), is amended to read:

16 Section 602.3. Deposit of Proceeds; Appropriation.--(a) The
17 proceeds resulting from one-half mill of the tax imposed
18 pursuant to this article as determined by the Secretary of
19 Revenue shall be transferred to the Hazardous Sites Cleanup
20 Fund. [The proceeds from any taxable year beginning in 1991
21 resulting from one-quarter mill of the tax imposed pursuant to

1 this article as determined by the Secretary of Revenue shall be
2 transferred to the State Lottery Fund.] The transfers required
3 by this subsection shall be made by June 15 and December 15 of
4 each appropriate calendar year.

5 (b) The funds deposited in the Hazardous Sites Cleanup Fund
6 and the State Lottery Fund are hereby appropriated out of this
7 account upon authorization by the Governor.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
