- 8 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 61 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 10 § 102. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this title shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 15 "Corrections manager." A corrections superintendent 1, 2 or
- 16 3, deputy superintendent 1, 2 or 3, corrections officer 3, 4 or
- 17 <u>5, unit manager, facility maintenance manager 1, 2 or 3, food</u>
- 18 service manager 1 or 2, inmate personal services manager,
- 19 classification and treatment manager, classification program

- 1 manager, correctional industries manager 1 or 2, utilities_
- 2 <u>supervisor</u>, motor freight coordinator and any other
- 3 classification that may be added to the corrections manager's
- 4 pay scale and supervises or administers security and custodial
- 5 <u>activities at the institutional or agency level.</u>

- 7 Section 2. Title 61 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1101.1. Salary of corrections managers.
- 9 <u>A corrections manager shall receive not less than the same</u>
- 10 <u>annual percentage salary and fringe benefit increase as received</u>
- 11 by the highest ranking corrections officer participating in
- 12 collective bargaining.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
