# HOUSE BILL <br>

AN ACT

Amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), entitled "An act providing for taxation by school districts, for the State funds formula, for tax relief in first class cities, for school district choice and voter participation, for other school district options and for a task force on school cost reduction; making an appropriation; prohibiting prior authorized taxation; providing for installment payment of taxes; restricting the power of certain school districts to levy, assess and collect taxes; and making related repeals," in senior citizens property tax and rent rebate assistance, further providing for property tax and rent rebate.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $1304(a)(2)(i)$ of the act of June 27, 2006
(1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief
Act, is amended to read:
Section 1304. Property tax; and rent rebate.
(a) Schedule of rebates.--

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(2) The following apply:
(i) The base amount of any claim for property tax rebate for real property taxes due and payable during
calendar year 2006 and thereafter shall be the larger of
an amount equal to $15 \%$ of the face amount of the real
property tax paid by the claimant on the claimant's
primary residence regardless of whether the taxes were
paid in the discount, face or penalty period during the
calendar year or an amount as determined in accordance
with the following schedule:
