14	(P.L.1262, No.156), known as the Local Option Small Games of
15	Chance Act, is amended by adding a definition to read:

17	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall,
18	except as provided under section 902, have the meanings given to
19	them in this section unless the context clearly indicates

22	"Texas Hold'em card tournament." A poker variant or

2	five community cards and the player's own two hole cards to make
3	a poker hand. In tournament format, a player may bet up to the
4	amount of chips the player possesses.

6	Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
7	Section 301.2. Texas Hold'em card tournaments.
8	(a) ConductNotwithstanding any other provision of this
9	act, Texas Hold'em card tournaments may be conducted by
10	volunteer fire companies to which a license has been issued
11	under this section up to four times per calendar year. All Texas
12	Hold'em card tournaments must be held on volunteer fire company
13	grounds. Revenue generated from Texas Hold'em card tournaments
14	shall be used for public interest purposes as permitted under
15	this chapter.
16	(b) Special licenseA special license shall be required
17	for volunteer fire companies to conduct up to four Texas Hold'em
18	<u>card tournaments per calendar year. A license fee of \$1,000</u>
19	shall be charged to permit volunteer fire companies to conduct
20	<u>up to four Texas Hold'em card tournaments per calendar year.</u>
21	(c) Entry feeA volunteer fire company may charge an entry
22	<u>fee of no more than \$100 per person.</u>
23	(d) PrizesNotwithstanding section 302, volunteer fire
24	companies shall pay out prizes to no more than the top five
25	winning persons in a declining manner based on the player's
26	final placement in the Texas Hold'em card tournament. The prize
27	pool shall be based on entry fees collected.
28	(e) Costs and profitsA volunteer fire company may keep up
29	to 60% of the entry fees collected.
