AN ACT

1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for Category 2 slot machine  
3 license.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1304(a) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1304. Category 2 slot machine license.

9 (a) Eligibility.--A person may be eligible to apply for a  
10 Category 2 license if the applicant, its affiliate,  
11 intermediary, subsidiary or holding company is not otherwise  
12 eligible to apply for a Category 1 license and the person is  
13 seeking to locate a licensed facility in a city of the first  
14 class, a city of the second class or a revenue- or tourism-  
15 enhanced location. Nothing in this title shall prohibit a mayor  
16 of the city of the second class, with the approval of the  
17 majority of the members of city council, from applying for a  
18 Category 2 license to locate a licensed facility in a city of

1 the second class. It shall not be a condition of eligibility to  
2 apply for a Category 2 license to obtain a license from either  
3 the State Horse Racing Commission or the State Harness Racing  
4 Commission to conduct thoroughbred or harness race meetings  
5 respectively with pari-mutuel wagering.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
