AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20 commissions shall be determined," further providing for the
21 salary of the State Athletic Commission.

22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
23 hereby enacts as follows:

24 Section 1. Section 427, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
25 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," amended
26 April 28, 1949 (P.L.776, No.192), is amended to read:

27 Section 427. State Athletic Commission.--The State Athletic

1 Commission shall consist of three members, who shall be
2 appointed for terms of two years, and the [Secretary of Revenue]
3 Secretary of the Commonwealth, ex officio.

4 Each member of the commission, except the [Secretary of
5 Revenue] Secretary of the Commonwealth and the chairman, shall
6 receive a salary of [seven thousand dollars] twelve thousand
7 dollars per annum and the chairman shall receive a salary of
8 [seven thousand five hundred dollars] twelve thousand five
9 hundred dollars per annum.

10 Two members of the commission shall constitute a quorum, and
11 the concurrence of at least two members of the commission shall
12 be necessary to render valid any action by the commission.

13 The commission may appoint such number of deputies as shall
14 be approved by the Executive Board, whose compensation shall be
15 fixed by the commission, with the approval of the Governor.

16 The commission may, with the approval of the [Secretary of
17 Revenue] Secretary of the Commonwealth, appoint a secretary, who
18 shall receive a salary to be fixed by the commission, with the
19 approval of the Governor.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
