AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for sentence of
3 imprisonment for felony.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1103 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1103. Sentence of imprisonment for felony.

9 (a) General rule.--A person who has been convicted of a
10 felony may be sentenced to imprisonment as follows:

11 (1) In the case of a felony of the first degree, for a
12 term which shall be fixed by the court at not more than 20
13 years.

14 (2) In the case of a felony of the second degree, for a
15 term which shall be fixed by the court at not more than ten
16 years.

17 (3) In the case of a felony of the third degree, for a

1 term which shall be fixed by the court at not more than seven
2 years.

3 (b) Minimum sentence for burglary or theft of firearm.--If a
4 person has been convicted of burglary or theft of one or more
5 firearms, the minimum sentence of imprisonment shall be one
6 year.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
