AN ACT

- 1 Providing for duty of Department of Environmental Protection to
 - prohibit the construction or installation of wind turbines
- that negatively affect military installations, for duties of
- wind turbine owners and for authorization processes.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Military
- 9 Installation Training Preservation Act.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of
- 15 the Commonwealth.
- 16 "Wind turbine." A wind turbine with a capacity of at least
- 17 100 kilowatts.

- 1 "Wind turbine owner." A person or entity that plans to
- 2 construct or install a wind turbine in this Commonwealth.
- 3 Section 3. Duty to prohibit construction of wind turbines that
- 4 negatively affect military installations.
- 5 The department shall have the duty to prohibit the
- 6 construction or installation of a wind turbine in an area or a
- 7 region of a military installation in this Commonwealth that may
- 8 affect the military installation's airspace, flight paths or
- 9 established training needs in accordance with this act.
- 10 Section 4. Duties of wind turbine owners.
- 11 (a) Duties.--For the purpose of assisting the department in
- 12 complying with section 3, a wind turbine owner shall, in a
- 13 manner specified by the department, apply for a request for
- 14 authorization from the department prior to engaging in the
- 15 construction or installation of wind turbines. In applying for a
- 16 request for authorization under this subsection, the wind
- 17 turbine owner shall provide notice to the department of all of
- 18 the following:
- 19 (1) The size of each proposed wind turbine.
- 20 (2) The number of proposed wind turbines.
- 21 (3) The area or region where each proposed wind turbine
- 22 will be constructed.
- 23 (4) Any other necessary information requested by the
- 24 department.
- 25 (b) Prohibition. -- A wind turbine owner may not engage in the
- 26 construction or installation of a wind turbine until the wind
- 27 turbine owner has received an authorization from the department
- 28 under section 5(c)(1) and any other required permits or
- 29 authorizations in accordance with the laws of this Commonwealth.
- 30 Section 5. Authorization processes.

- 1 (a) Forms and methods. -- The department shall establish a
- 2 form and method to allow a wind turbine owner to apply for a
- 3 request for authorization under section 4(a). Upon receipt of a
- 4 request for authorization under section 4(a), the department
- 5 shall immediately forward the request to the Adjutant General.
- 6 (b) Duties of Adjutant General. -- No later than 60 days after
- 7 receipt of the request for authorization forwarded by the
- 8 department under subsection (a), the Adjutant General shall
- 9 review the request and provide comments or information to the
- 10 department regarding whether a proposed wind turbine will
- 11 negatively impact a military installation's airspace, flight
- 12 paths or established training needs.
- 13 (c) Grant of authorization.--
- 14 (1) The department shall grant an authorization for the 15 construction or installation of a proposed wind turbine to a 16 wind turbine owner if any of the following apply:
- 17 (i) The department receives comments or information
 18 from the Adjutant General under subsection (b) that the
 19 proposed wind turbine will not negatively impact a
 20 military installation's airspace, flight paths or
 21 established training needs.
 - (ii) The department receives no comments or information under subsection (b) from the Adjutant General within 60 days after receipt of the request for authorization forwarded by the department under subsection (a).
- (2) The department may not grant an authorization for
 the construction or installation of a proposed wind turbine
 to a wind turbine owner if the department receives comments
 or information from the Adjutant General under subsection (b)

- 1 that the proposed wind turbine may negatively impact a
- 2 military installation's airspace, flight paths or established
- 3 training needs.
- 4 (d) Other permits or authorization. -- The department may not
- 5 issue any other required permits or authorizations under the
- 6 laws of this Commonwealth regarding the construction or
- 7 installation of a proposed wind turbine until the department
- 8 grants an authorization for the construction or installation of
- 9 the proposed wind turbine to the wind turbine owner under
- 10 subsection (c)(1).
- 11 Section 6. Applicability.
- 12 This act shall apply to a wind turbine that commences
- 13 operations on or after the effective date of this section,
- 14 regardless of the status of any other of the wind turbine's
- 15 permits or authorizations required under the laws of this
- 16 Commonwealth. A wind turbine that will commence operations on or
- 17 after the effective date of this section shall obtain the
- 18 authorization required under section 5(c)(1) prior to commencing
- 19 operations and shall be prohibited from commencing operations
- 20 until the authorization has been granted by the department.
- 21 Section 7. Effective date.
- 22 This act shall take effect immediately.
