## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in common carriers, providing for
- 3 paratransit service.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 \\$ 2306. Paratransit service.
- 9 (a) Third-party presence required. -- A third party shall be
- 10 present in the facility of a paratransit service provider when
- 11 the paratransit service provider is transporting a minor with a
- 12 physical disability, an intellectual disability or an autism
- 13 <u>spectrum disorder</u>.
- 14 (b) Permissible third parties. -- The third party under
- 15 <u>subsection</u> (a) <u>shall be one of the following:</u>
- 16 (1) The parent or legal guardian of the minor.
- 17 (2) An agent of the county agency.
- 18 (3) A health care practitioner.

- 1 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 3 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 "Agent of the county agency." Includes any of the following:
- 5 (1) A person or a representative of a person providing
- 6 <u>child protective services or general protective services, as</u>
- 7 those terms are defined in 23 Pa.C.S. § 6303 (relating to
- 8 <u>definitions</u>), to the minor directly or under contract or
- 9 <u>agreement with the county agency.</u>
- 10 (2) A staff member of any of the following:
- 11 <u>(i) A public or private residential child-care</u>
- 12 <u>facility.</u>
- 13 <u>(ii) A public or private day-care center, group day-</u>
- 14 <u>care home or family day-care home.</u>
- 15 <u>(iii) A public or private social service agency.</u>
- 16 (iv) A county detention center.
- 17 (3) An individual residing in the home of a parent or
- 18 legal quardian of the minor.
- 19 (4) A school employee of a facility or agency that is an
- 20 agent of a county agency.
- 21 <u>"Autism spectrum disorder." As defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 5992</u>
- 22 (relating to definitions).
- 23 "County agency." The county children and youth social
- 24 service agency established under section 405 of the act of June
- 25 24, 1937 (P.L.2017, No.396), known as the County Institution
- 26 District Law, or its successor, and supervised by the department
- 27 under Article IX of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21),
- 28 known as the Human Services Code.
- 29 "Department." The Department of Human Services of the
- 30 Commonwealth.

- 1 <u>"Health care practitioner." An individual who is authorized</u>
- 2 to practice some component of the healing arts by license,
- 3 permit, certificate or registration issued by a Commonwealth
- 4 <u>licensing agency or board.</u>
- 5 <u>"Intellectual disability." Significantly subaverage general</u>
- 6 intellectual functioning of an individual that is accompanied by
- 7 <u>significant limitations in at least two of the following skill</u>
- 8 areas:
- 9 <u>(1) Communication.</u>
- 10 (2) Self-care.
- 11 (3) Home living.
- 12 <u>(4) Social and interpersonal.</u>
- 13 <u>(5) Use of community resources.</u>
- 14 <u>(6) Self-direction.</u>
- 15 <u>(7) Functional academic.</u>
- 16 (8) Work.
- 17 (9) Health and safety.
- 18 "Minor." An individual under 18 years of age.
- 19 "Paratransit service provider." A common carrier that
- 20 operates on a nonfixed-route basis to provide transportation
- 21 services to individuals who are functionally unable to use a
- 22 fixed-route public transportation service as required by the
- 23 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336, 104
- 24 Stat. 327).
- 25 "Physical disability." As follows:
- 26 (1) A permanent or irreversible physical impairment,
- 27 whether congenital or acquired by accident, injury or
- disease, that substantially limits one or more major life
- 29 activities of the individual.
- 30 (2) For purposes of paragraph (1), major life activities

- include, but are not limited to, caring for oneself,
- performing manual tasks, seeing, hearing, eating, sleeping,
- 3 walking, standing, lifting, bending, speaking, breathing and
- 4 working.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
