AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for overtaking vehicle on the
3 right.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3304 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 3304. Overtaking vehicle on the right.

9 (a) General rule.--The driver of a vehicle may overtake and
10 pass upon the right of another vehicle only [under one of the
11 following conditions:

12 (1) When] when the vehicle overtaken is making or about
13 to make a left turn, except that such movement shall not be
14 made by driving off the berm or shoulder of the highway.

15 [(2) Upon a roadway with unobstructed pavement of
16 sufficient width for two or more lines of vehicles moving
17 lawfully in the direction being traveled by the overtaken
18 vehicle, except that such movement shall not be made by

1 driving off the roadway.]

2 (b) Limitation.--No passing movement under this section
3 shall be made unless the movement can be made in safety.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60
5 days.
