## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 9, 1949 (P.L.927, No.261), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act fixing and regulating the fees, commissions, 3 mileage and other costs chargeable by the sheriff in counties of the second, second A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes for their official acts and the services 5 6 of their deputies, watchmen, appraisers and other agents; 7 requiring prepayment of same, unless secured or chargeable to the county, and delivery of itemized receipts therefor; 8 9 requiring certain payments by the county, including the compensation of special deputies; providing for the taxation 10 and collection of fees, commissions, mileage and other costs; 11 requiring salaried sheriffs to account to the county for 12 certain fees and commissions collected; and repealing 13 14 inconsistent laws, general, special or local, " changing the 15 fee for compensation for deputy sheriffs. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Subsection (1) of section 1, act of May 9, 1949 Section 1. (P.L.927, No.261), referred to as the Sheriff Fee Law of 1949, 19 amended April 28, 1978 (P.L.99, No.45), is amended to read: 20 21 In all counties of the second, second A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes, the fees and 23 costs, including commissions and mileage, to be charged and received by the sheriff from persons or counties requiring their 24

- 1 services shall be as follows:

- 3 (1) For services performed in his capacity as a conservator
- 4 of the peace or police officer, in suppressing riots, mobs or
- 5 insurrections, and when discharging any duty requiring the
- 6 summoning of a posse comitatus or special deputy sheriffs, the
- 7 sheriff shall receive per diem compensation at the rate of
- 8 thirty dollars in any county for eight hours' service, together
- 9 with the mileage and necessary expenses, including subsistence
- 10 for himself and those under him, to be paid by the county.
- 11 For each special deputy appointed by any sheriff, in case of
- 12 any emergency, to assist him in executing any civil or criminal
- 13 process or court order, or preserving the peace, such sheriff
- 14 may charge and shall receive from the county compensation for
- 15 such deputy, at the rate of [three dollars seventy-five cents]
- 16 five dollars in any county for one hour's service, in addition
- 17 to the expenses incurred for the transportation and subsistence
- 18 of such deputy while rendering such service.

- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
