AN ACT

Amending the act of June 16, 1994 (P.L., No.6A), entitled, "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of 2 3 the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the 4 Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1994, to June 30, 1995, for certain 6 institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 1994; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization 10 Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores Fund, the 11 12 Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust Fund, the 13 Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund, the Ben Franklin/IRC Partnership Fund and the Tuition Payment Fund to 14 15 the Executive Department; to provide appropriations from the 16 Judicial Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial 17 Department; to provide appropriations from the Motor License 18 Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 1994, to June 30, 1995, for 19 the proper operation of the several departments of the 20 Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the 21 22 appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive and Judicial 23 Departments of the Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipt accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 1994, 24 25 to June 30, 1995, and for the payment of bills remaining 26 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994; 27 and to provide for the additional appropriation of State and 28 Federal funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 1993, to June 29 30 30, 1994, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining 31 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993," 32 increasing the appropriation for the operation of the Auditor 33 General.

- 2 hereby enacts as follows:
- 3 Section 1. As much of the appropriation as relates to the
- 4 operations of the Auditor General in section 205 of the act of
- 5 June 16, 1994 (P.L., No.6A), known as the General
- 6 Appropriation Act of 1994, is amended to read:
- 7 Section 205. Auditor General.--The
- 8 following amounts are appropriated to
- 9 the Auditor General: Federal State
- 10 For the Department of the Auditor
- 11 General for auditing, annually,
- 12 periodically or specially, the affairs
- 13 of any department, board or commission
- 14 which is supported out of the General
- 15 Fund, district justices, other fining
- 16 offices, Volunteer Firemen's Relief
- 17 Association Funds and the offices of
- 18 elected State officials and for the
- 19 proper auditing of appropriations for
- 20 or relating to public assistance,
- 21 including any Federal sums
- 22 supplementing such appropriations.

- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
