- 1 Supporting House Resolution No. 380 of the 109th Congress of the
 - United States which would exclude from gross income certain
- 3 disaster mitigation payments.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard
- 5 Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) has provided funds to families
- 6 in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and nationwide whose homes
- 7 must be removed from harm's way for their own personal safety
- 8 and to reduce future damage costs to homeowners and to the
- 9 Federal Government; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Internal Revenue Service has determined that
- 11 HMGP funds are includable as gross income under 26 U.S.C. § 61;

- 13 WHEREAS, The potential tax impact on the homeowners who have
- 14 received the HMGP funds is in the tens of thousands of dollars;

- 16 WHEREAS, House Resolution No. 380 amends the Internal Revenue

- 1 Code of 1986 to exclude from gross income certain disaster
- 2 mitigation payments; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 support House Resolution No. 380; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the Senate memorialize Congress to consider
- 6 amending the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude from gross
- 7 income certain hazard mitigation assistance.
