## A RESOLUTION

- Designating July 31, 2015, as "Heat Stroke Prevention Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Heat stroke is the leading cause of noncrash
- 4 vehicle-related fatalities for children who are 14 years of age
- 5 or younger; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Unfortunately, even a great parent can forget a
- 7 child in the back seat of a vehicle; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Risk factors that may lead to heat stroke in
- 9 children left in a vehicle include a caregiver who is not
- 10 accustomed to driving with a child in the vehicle and a
- 11 caregiver whose routine suddenly changes; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Heat stroke deaths have been recorded in 11 months
- 13 of the year in nearly all 50 states, including Pennsylvania; and
- 14 WHEREAS, July 31 is recognized as "National Heat Stroke
- 15 Prevention Day"; and
- 16 WHEREAS, We can all help to reduce the number of injuries and
- 17 deaths caused by heat stroke by raising public awareness of the

- 2 occurring; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate July 31, 2015, as "Heat
- 4 Stroke Prevention Day" in Pennsylvania.
