- 4 billion annually on massage therapy; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Therapeutic massage can benefit people of all ages;

- WHEREAS, According to a recent survey, 22% of consumers
- 8 reported having a massage from a massage therapist in the past
- 9 12 months; and
- 10 WHEREAS, An estimated 46.9 million American adults had a
- 11 massage in the past 12 months, which was 2.2 million more than
- 12 the previous year; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The American Massage Therapy Association (AMTA), a
- 14 52,000-member professional association for massage therapists,
- 15 provides consumer and professional education on massage and
- 16 helps consumers and health professionals locate qualified
- 17 massage therapists in their area; therefore be it
