AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in falsification and intimidation,
3 further providing for false identification to law enforcement
4 authorities and imposing an additional penalty.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 4914 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 4914. False identification to law enforcement authorities.

10 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits an offense if he
11 furnishes law enforcement authorities with false information
12 about his identity, or fails to disclose employment information,
13 after being informed by a law enforcement officer who is in
14 uniform or who has identified himself as a law enforcement
15 officer that the person is the subject of an official
16 investigation of a violation of law.

17 (b) Grading.--An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
18 of the third degree.

1 (c) Penalty.--In addition to any other penalty that may be
2 imposed, a person convicted under this section shall be
3 sentenced to pay a fine of at least \$1,000.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
