## AN ACT

6	Section 1. Section 2702 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania	<

8	§ 2702. Aggravated assault.	
9	(a) Offense defined. A person is guilty of aggravated	
10	assault if he:	
11	(1) attempts to cause serious bodily injury to another,	
12	or causes such injury intentionally, knowingly or recklessly	
13	under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the	
14	<del>value of human life;</del>	
15	(2) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or	
16	recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the	
17	officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in	

subsection (c) or to an employee of an agency, company or

other entity engaged in public transportation, while in the

performance of duty;

(3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), in the performance of duty;

(4) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon;

causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board member or other employee, including a student employee, of any elementary or secondary publicly funded educational institution, any elementary or secondary private school licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or secondary parochial school while acting in the scope of his or her employment or because of his or her employment relationship to the school; or

(6) attempts by physical menace to put any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), while in the performance of duty, in fear of imminent serious bodily injury.

(b) Grading. Aggravated assault under subsection (a)(1) and
(2) is a felony of the first degree. Aggravated assault under
subsection (a)(3), (4), (5) and (6) is a felony of the second
degree.

(c) Officers, employees, etc., enumerated. The officers, agents, employees and other persons referred to in subsection (a) shall be as follows:
