AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, providing for moment of silence on September 11 anniversary and for moment of silence on December 7, Pearl Harbor Day. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding sections 11 12 to read: 13 Section 1555. Moment of Silence on September 11 14 Anniversary. -- (a) Beginning with school year 2020 2021 2021-2022 and any subsequent school year when September 11 occurs on a school day, each school entity shall conduct a moment of 16 silence during instructional hours for students and faculty to 17 observe the anniversary of September 11, 2001, as a remembrance 18

- 1 of the thousands of military service persons, government
- 2 employees, civilians and emergency responders who lost their
- 3 <u>lives or were wounded by terrorist attacks on that date.</u>
- 4 (b) Beginning with the 2020 2021 2021-2022 school year, the <--
- 5 Department of Education shall make available to all school
- 6 <u>entities voluntary in-service training programs based upon the</u>
- 7 moment of silence provided for under subsection (a).
- 8 (c) The Department of Education shall establish a model
- 9 <u>curriculum for instruction in the events and significance of</u>
- 10 September 11, 2001, no later than twelve (12) months after the
- 11 effective date of this section. The model curriculum shall
- 12 <u>include</u>, but not be limited to, all of the following topics
- 13 where appropriate:
- 14 (1) The historical context of terrorism.
- 15 (2) The terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center, the
- 16 Pentagon and United Airlines Flight 93 which crashed in
- 17 Shanksville, Pennsylvania.
- 18 (3) American recovery and response to the attacks.
- 19 (4) Global challenges and consequences in a post-September
- 20 <u>11 world.</u>
- 21 (d) The Department of Education shall make available on the
- 22 department's publicly accessible Internet website curriculum
- 23 materials and other available resources regarding the events and
- 24 significance of September 11, 2001, for voluntary use by school
- 25 entities.
- 26 (e) The Department of Education shall provide the model
- 27 <u>curriculum</u>, <u>voluntary in-service training and any other</u>
- 28 materials developed in accordance with this section to any
- 29 <u>nonpublic school within this Commonwealth upon receiving a</u>
- 30 request from the nonpublic school.

- 1 (f) Nothing in subsections (c) and (d) shall be construed to
- 2 require a school entity or nonpublic school to implement, adopt
- 3 or use the curriculum, materials and other resources made
- 4 <u>available by the department under this section.</u>
- 5 (q) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 6 <u>shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter</u>
- 7 <u>school</u>, <u>cyber charter school</u>, <u>intermediate unit or area career</u>
- 8 and technical school.
- 9 Section 1556. Moment of Silence on December 7, Pearl Harbor
- 10 Day. -- (a) Beginning with school year 2021-2022 and any
- 11 <u>subsequent school year when Pearl Harbor Day occurs on a school</u>
- 12 day, each school entity shall conduct a moment of silence during
- 13 <u>instructional hours for students and faculty to observe the</u>
- 14 <u>anniversary of Pearl Harbor Day as a remembrance of the 3,546</u>
- 15 military service persons who lost their lives or were wounded by
- 16 the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941.
- 17 (b) Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, the Department
- 18 of Education shall make available to all school entities
- 19 <u>voluntary in-service training programs based upon the moment of</u>
- 20 silence provided for under subsection (a) and model curriculum
- 21 guidelines.
- 22 (c) The Department of Education shall provide the model
- 23 quidelines, voluntary in-service training and any other
- 24 materials developed in accordance with this section to any
- 25 <u>nonpublic school within this Commonwealth upon receiving a</u>
- 26 request from the nonpublic school.
- 27 (d) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 28 shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter
- 29 school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or career and
- 30 <u>technical school</u>.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
