## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania providing for filling vacancies in the office
- of justice, judge or justice of the peace.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 8 the provisions of the eleventh article thereof:
- 9 That subsection (b) of section thirteen of article five of
- 10 the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be amended
- 11 to read:
- 12 Section 13. Election of Justices, Judges and Justices of the
- 13 Peace; Vacancies. -- \* \* \*
- 14 (b) A vacancy in the office of justice, judge or justice of
- 15 the peace shall be filled by appointment by the Governor. The
- 16 appointment shall be with the advice and consent of two-thirds
- 17 of the members elected to the Senate, except in the case of
- 18 justices of the peace which shall be by a majority. The person

- 1 so appointed shall serve for [an initial]  $\underline{a}$  term ending on the
- 2 first Monday of January following the next municipal election
- 3 more than ten months after the vacancy occurs or for the
- 4 remainder of the unexpired term whichever is less.
