Appropriations.--(a) Motor License Fund.--The 10 11 following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated from the Motor License Fund to the 12 13 hereinafter named agencies of the Commonwealth for the payment 14 of salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses of 15 the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the 16 Commonwealth, for contractual services and other expenses 17 necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and 18 activities for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1989, and for the payment of bills 19 20 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 21 ending June 30, 1989. 22 (b) Aviation Restricted Revenue Account. -- The following 23 sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby 24 appropriated from the Aviation Restricted Revenue Account in the 25 Motor License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the

27 year beginning July 1, 1989, and for the payment of bills 28 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 29 ending June 30, 1989.

Effective date. -- This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or immediately, whichever is later. 29
