AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in intermediate units, providing for
- Retired Volunteer Educator Tutor Program.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 923.4-A. Retired Volunteer Educator Tutor Program.--</u>
- 13 (a) Establishment. The Retired Volunteer Educator Tutor Program
- 14 is established.
- 15 (b) Purpose. The program shall provide for individualized
- 16 tutoring sessions by retired volunteer educators for students of
- 17 a school district during a mandated school closure under a
- 18 <u>disaster emergency to assist all of the following:</u>
- 19 (1) Students attending the school district with limited
- 20 technology resources in their homes.

- 1 (2) Students attending the school district who are
- 2 <u>identified by the school district as having difficulty with</u>
- 3 online or distance learning.
- 4 (c) Requirements. The following apply:
- 5 (1) The tutoring sessions shall be conducted by telephone
- 6 with retired volunteer educators assisting students who are
- 7 <u>identified by the school district as meeting the requirements</u>
- 8 under subsection (b).
- 9 (2) The parent or quardian of the student shall be permitted
- 10 to monitor the telephone session with the student.
- 11 (d) Operation. The program shall be operated by the
- 12 intermediate unit that serves the school district.
- (e) Model items. The department shall provide collaboration
- 14 and guidance to the intermediate units as needed, with model
- 15 items such as implementation of the program, replication of a
- 16 model program or standardization of a statement for the
- 17 student's parent or quardian to sign for participation in the
- 18 program.
- 19 (f) Collaboration. As the need for virtual education
- 20 increases, the department and intermediate units shall
- 21 collaborate to:
- 22 (1) evaluate and share information on the impact of the
- 23 program; and
- 24 (2) investigate methods to virtually provide social wrap-
- 25 <u>around services and school guidance counseling services.</u>
- 26 (q) Definitions. As used in this section:
- 27 "Department" means the Department of Education of the
- 28 Commonwealth.
- 29 "Disaster emergency" means a declaration of disaster
- 30 emergency issued by the Governor under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c)

- 1 <u>(relating to general authority of Governor)</u>.
- 2 <u>"Online or distance learning" includes the provision of</u>
- 3 continuity of education to students using alternative means
- 4 <u>during a period of closure due to a disaster emergency.</u>
- 5 <u>"Program" means the Retired Volunteer Educator Tutor Program.</u>
- 6 <u>"School district" means a school district that has been</u>
- 7 ordered closed under a disaster emergency and that offers online
- 8 or distance learning as a part of its continuity of education.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
