- 1 Amending Title 64 (Public Authorities and Quasi-Public
- 2 Corporations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes,
- 3 providing for termination of powers and duties and for
- 4 expiration; and imposing functions on the Legislative
- 5 Reference Bureau.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Title 64 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
- 10 § 1515. Termination of powers and duties.
- 11 The authority shall not issue any bonds under this chapter
- 12 and shall not fund the programs established in Subchapter E
- 13 (relating to programs) and 12 Pa.C.S. Ch. 29 (relating to
- 14 machinery and equipment loans) on and after the effective date
- 15 of this section. Bonds issued prior to the effective date of
- 16 this section shall remain valid and binding obligations of the
- 17 <u>authority</u>.
- 18 § 1516. Dissolution of authority, transfer of funds and
- 19 expiration of chapter.

- 1 (a) Publication of notice. -- Upon the date of full payment
- 2 and discharge of the last remaining outstanding bonds issued by
- 3 the authority, together with the interest on the bonds, the
- 4 <u>authority shall transmit notice to the Legislative Reference</u>
- 5 Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 6 (b) Effect of notice. -- Upon publication in the Pennsylvania
- 7 Bulletin of the notice under subsection (a), all of the
- 8 following shall occur:
- 9 <u>(1) The authority shall be dissolved.</u>
- 10 (2) All funds, assets and other property of the
- 11 <u>authority shall vest in the Commonwealth.</u>
- 12 (3) This chapter shall expire.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
