1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the concurrence of the Department of Environmental Resources, in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to sell and convey to Scott Paper Company three tracts of land within the bed of the Delaware River in the City of Chester, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, lying between the Bulkhead Line and the Pierhead Line of the Delaware River, adjacent to lands presently owned by the said corporation, to the north, containing 12.5045 acres, more or less
10	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
11	hereby enacts as follows:
12	Section 1. The Department of Property and Supplies, with
13	concurrence of the Department of Environmental Resources, acting
14	on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for a respective
15	consideration which shall be the actual market value of each of
16	the respective tracts of property hereinafter described as
17	determined by an independent appraisal service chosen by the
18	Secretary of Property and Supplies, is hereby authorized to
19	convey in fee to Scott Paper Company, a corporation with offices
20	in the City of Chester, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, its
21	successors and assigns, Tract #1 and/or Tract #2 and/or Tract #3

- 1 within the bed of the Delaware River hereinafter described by
- 2 one or more conveyances conveying one or more of the three
- 3 tracts hereinafter described as may be requested by said Scott
- 4 Paper Company, the said three tracts lying between the Bulkhead
- 5 Line and the Pierhead Line as approved by the War Department on
- 6 September 10, 1940, adjacent to lands presently owned by the
- 7 corporation, to the north, the said three tracts being
- 8 separately bounded and described as follows:
- 9 Tract No. 1
- 10 PULP DOCK AND WASTE TREATMENT DOCK
- 11 All that certain parcel of land with any improvements
- 12 thereon, situated in the City of Chester, County of Delaware,
- 13 State of Pennsylvania, being described according to a plan
- 14 thereof dated November 1, 1973, prepared by S. E. Price, P. E.,
- 15 Scott Paper Company, Chester, Pennsylvania, as follows:
- 16 Beginning at the intersection of the westerly side of former
- 17 Market Street (75 feet wide vacated) now lands of Scott Paper
- 18 Company, with the U.S.E.D. Bulkhead Line of the Delaware River
- 19 as approved by the War Department, September 10, 1940. Thence
- 20 from said point of beginning along the Bulkhead Line north 55
- 21 degrees 50 minutes 36.2 seconds east, the distance of 760.38
- 22 feet to a drill hole, said drill hole located on the Bulkhead
- 23 Line 0.79 feet easterly from the east wall of the Scott Paper
- 24 Company Primary Waste Treatment Plant; thence south 31 degrees
- 25 38 minutes 09 seconds east, the distance of 122.94 feet to a
- 26 point; thence south 58 degrees 26 minutes 46.2 seconds west, the
- 27 distance of 760.55 feet along the riverside face of the Waste
- 28 Treatment Plant and the Pulp Dock to the southwesterly corner of
- 29 the Pulp Dock; thence north 32 degrees 21 minutes 38.6 seconds
- 30 west, the distance of 88.32 feet to a point in the Bulkhead

- 1 Line; thence north 55 degrees 50 minutes 36.2 seconds east the
- 2 distance of 2.02 feet to the first mentioned point and place of
- 3 beginning.
- 4 Containing 1.8458 acres of land.
- 5 Tract No. 2
- 6 FORMER SUN SHIP LAUNCHING AREA
- 7 All that certain parcel of river bottom land between the low
- 8 water line and the U.S.E.D. Pierhead Line of the Delaware River
- 9 as approved by the War Department, September 10, 1940, situated
- 10 in the City of Chester, County of Delaware, State of
- 11 Pennsylvania, being described according to a plan thereof dated
- 12 November 1, 1973, prepared by S. E. Price, P. E., Scott Paper
- 13 Company, Chester, Pennsylvania, as follows:
- 14 Beginning at a point on the Pierhead Line, which said point
- 15 is measured the two following courses and distances from the
- 16 intersection of the westerly side of former Market Street (75
- 17 feet wide vacated) with the U.S.E.D. Bulkhead Line: (one)
- 18 north 55 degrees 50 minutes 36.2 seconds east along the Bulkhead
- 19 Line, the distance of 1654.34 feet to an existing monument in
- 20 line of lands of Sun Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company; and
- 21 (two) south 38 degrees 19 minutes 28.8 seconds east along the
- 22 line of lands of Sun Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company, the
- 23 distance of 253.52 feet to the point of beginning on the
- 24 Pierhead Line; thence from said point of beginning along the
- 25 Pierhead Line south 51 degrees 36 minutes 32.4 seconds west, the
- 26 distance of 186.01 feet to point "H" of Harbor Lines; thence
- 27 still along same south 53 degrees 36 minutes 37.3 seconds west,
- 28 the distance of 740.46 feet to a point; thence north 31 degrees
- 29 38 minutes 09 seconds west, the distance of approximately 248
- 30 feet to the Low Water Line surveyed October 25, 1963; thence

- 1 easterly along the Low Water Line to a point on the line of
- 2 lands of Sun Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company; thence south 38
- 3 degrees 19 minutes 28.8 seconds east, the distance of
- 4 approximately 14 feet to the first mentioned point and place of
- 5 beginning.
- 6 Containing 2.1847 acres of land under water, more or less.
- 7 Tract No. 3
- 8 LANDS UNDER WATER TO PIERHEAD LINE
- 9 All that certain parcel of river bottom land lying between
- 10 the U.S.E.D. Bulkhead and Pierhead Lines of the Delaware River
- 11 as approved by the War Department, September 10, 1940, situated
- 12 in the City of Chester, County of Delaware, State of
- 13 Pennsylvania, being described according to a plan thereof dated
- 14 November 1, 1973, prepared by S. E. Price, P. E., Scott Paper
- 15 Company, Chester, Pennsylvania, as follows:
- 16 Beginning at a point on the Bulkhead Line, which said point
- 17 is measured south 55 degrees 50 minutes 36.2 seconds west, the
- 18 distance of 2.02 feet from the intersection of the westerly side
- 19 of former Market Street (75 feet wide vacated) with the
- 20 Bulkhead Line; thence from said point of beginning along the
- 21 west face of the Pulp Dock south 32 degrees 21 minutes 38.6
- 22 seconds east, the distance of 88.32 feet to a point; thence
- 23 north 58 degrees 26 minutes 46.2 seconds east along the
- 24 southerly face of the Pulp Dock the distance of 760.55 feet to a
- 25 point; thence south 31 degrees 38 minutes 09 seconds east, the
- 26 distance of 172.79 feet to a point in the Pierhead Line; thence
- 27 south 53 degrees 36 minutes 37.3 seconds west, the distance of
- 28 1421.87 feet to a point of intersection of the said Pierhead
- 29 Line with the extension of the westerly boundary of the lands of
- 30 Scott Paper Company abutting Edgmont Avenue; thence from said

- 1 point north 23 degrees 34 minutes 14.6 seconds west, the
- 2 distance of 356.91 feet to a point in the Bulkhead line; thence
- 3 north 55 degrees 50 minutes 36.2 seconds east, the distance of
- 4 605.74 feet to the first mentioned point and place of beginning.
- 5 Containing 8.4740 acres of land under water.
- 6 Section 2. The deed or deeds of conveyance hereby
- 7 contemplated shall be executed by the Department of Property and
- 8 Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania after
- 9 approval by the Department of Justice with the concurrence of
- 10 the Department of Environmental Resources.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
