AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An
2 act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor
3 Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and
4 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of
5 vehicles and tractors," prohibiting the turning back of an
6 odometer and providing penalties.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known
10 as "The Vehicle Code," is amended by adding a section to read:

11 Section 1227. Unlawful to Turn Back Odometer.--

12 It shall be unlawful for any person to turn back the mileage
13 as registered on any odometer.

14 Penalty.--Any person violating the provisions of this section
15 shall, upon summary conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of
16 one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and costs of prosecution, and in
17 default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for
18 not more than ten (10) days.
