AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12 boards commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20 commissions shall be determined," creating the Pennsylvania
21 State Park and Harbor Commission and imposing powers and
22 duties thereon.

23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
24 hereby enacts as follows:

25 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
26 as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended by adding
27 sections to read:

28 Section 434.1. Pennsylvania State Park and Harbor Commission

1 of Erie.--The Pennsylvania State Park and Harbor Commission of
2 Erie shall consist of the Secretary of Environmental Resources,
3 the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, ex
4 officio, and nine other persons, of whom two shall be appointed
5 by the council of the City of Erie, two by the commissioners of
6 the county of Erie and five by the Governor with the consent of
7 the Senate.

8 The commission shall annually elect a chairman and a
9 secretary.

10 Five members of the commission shall constitute a quorum.

11 Section 2807-A. Pennsylvania State Park and Harbor
12 Commission of Erie.--Subject to any inconsistent provisions in
13 this act contained, the Pennsylvania State Park and Harbor
14 Commission of Erie shall continue to exercise the powers and
15 perform the duties by law vested in and imposed upon the said
16 commission.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
