AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare for 2 the publicizing of the "Operation Peace of Mind" program. MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 3 WELFARE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-1976 FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE 4 5 PAYMENTS. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. The sum of \$30,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public 10 Welfare in order to publicize the "Operation Peace of Mind" program which is a National toll free hot line for runaways. 11 12 SECTION 1. THE SUM OF \$31,000,000 IS HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR THE FISCAL 13 YEAR 1975-1976 FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENTS AS A SUPPLEMENTAL 14 APPROPRIATION IN ADDITION TO ANY MONEYS HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED 15

- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
