AN ACT

1 Requiring Federal Government gasoline mileage test results to be  
2 disclosed to purchasers of new motor vehicles.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Mileage Test Results Disclosure.--Any person who  
6 offers for sale any new motor vehicle for which an agency of the  
7 Federal Government has determined by testing an average rating  
8 of miles per gallon of gasoline shall disclose in writing to any  
9 potential purchaser of such motor vehicle the results of the  
10 mileage test for the make and model of the motor vehicle  
11 involved.

12 Section 2. Regulations.--The Attorney General may by  
13 regulations promulgate standards for mileage test results  
14 disclosure.

15 Section 3. Effective Date.--This act shall take effect in 60  
16 days.
