## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act providing property tax or rent rebate to 3 certain senior citizens, widows, widowers and permanently disabled persons with limited incomes; establishing uniform 4 5 standards and qualifications for eligibility to receive a rebate; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue," 6 7 further providing for payment of administrative expenses and 8 claims.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 8, act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), 11 Section 1. 12 known as the "Senior Citizens Property Tax or Rent Rebate Act," 13 reenacted and amended June 16, 1975 (No.4) is amended to read: 14 Section 8. Funds for Payment of Administrative Expenses and 15 Claims. -- Expenses, salaries and other costs incurred in the administration of this act and approved claims shall be paid 16 17 from the State Lottery Fund established by the act of August 26, 18 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the "State Lottery Law." In the

event that the total amount of administrative expenses and
claims exceeds the [amount in] <u>FUNDS AVAILABLE INCLUDING revenue</u> <---</li>
<u>estimated to be available for these purposes in such fund, in</u>
any one year, then the percentages allowed as tax or rent
rebates shall be reduced in the proportion that the <u>ESTIMATED</u> <---</li>
amount of such [fund] <u>available revenue</u> bears to the total
amount of claims in such year.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
